## Basic Requirements

- Must be familiar with basic computer systems
- Must be willing to work during non-business hours as needed

## Salary

This position requires approximately 10–15 hours per week, many during late nights. The salary level is competitive and based upon prior experience.

## Typical Duties & Responsibilities

- Work with General Manager and Station Manager to identify station direction and programming strategy
- Implement programming decisions made by management staff
- Work with the Music Director on weekly rotation
- Work with Training Director on staffing issues
- Oversee daily programming
- Be on call Sunday 6PM - Friday 6PM (holiday's not included)
- Evaluate and discipline DJ staff, and enforce rules as necessary
- Train new staff when appropriate
- Maintain frequent communications with staff
- Fill in when and where necessary to accomplish stated objectives
