Basic Qualifications

- Must be a student at Michigan State University
- Must have working knowledge of digital audio workstation software for production (e.g. Pro Tools, Logic, Audacity, Adobe Audition, etc)
- Good understanding of applied sound design and signal processing effects (e.g. compressors, EQ, reverb, delay, etc) preferred

Preferred Qualifications

- Self-directed and effectively able to complete projects in a timely manner
- Completed at least a 300 level course on audio production
- A portfolio highlighting audio or music production

Salary

This position requires approximately 5–10 hours per week and is project based. The salary level is competitive and based upon prior experience.
