Basic Qualifications

- **Must be a student at Michigan State University**
- Must be a trained Live DJ or Voice-Tracker of MSU Student Radio
- Must be available during show's time slot (Sunday 9-11pm) and prepare / pre-program show
 - (i.e. creating a 2 hour playlist for live airplay)
- Must be able to produce and host every show
- Must have an active interest in chillwave and downtempo music

Typical Duties & Responsibilities

- Work closely with Station Manager and Program Director on overall sound of the show
- Work closely with Program Director on the programming of the show
- Work closely with Music Director on music screening and selection
- Create a weekly playlist
- Update social media throughout the week and during the show
- Communicate with campus organizations to promote community events
- Update the DJ info packet weekly with updates to the show
