Basic Qualifications

- Must be a student at Michigan State University
- Must have experience troubleshooting audio equipment
- Must have working knowledge of digital audio workstation software for production, such as Pro Tools, Logic, Audacity, Adobe Audition, etc.
- Good understanding of applied sound design and signal processing effects, such as compressors, EQ, reverb, delay, etc.
- Self-directed and effectively able to complete projects in a timely manner

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience with digital audio networks
- Familiar with radio sound boards
- Completed at least a 300-level course on Audio
- A portfolio highlighting audio or music production
- Experience in previous leadership positions

Typical Duties & Responsibilities

- Troubleshoot technical issues and equipment problems as they arise
- Work closely with Station Management to complete projects in support of programming strategy goals
- Write and record scripts for PSAs and station promotions
- Select and layer music and sound effects to create imaginative scenes
- Assist in providing the Program Director with new and current production
- Lead audio/production department
- Perform other duties as assigned
